Modified Firefighter Games

Wednesday July 27, 2022 (Intermission)

The Augusta County Fair Modified Firefighter Games includes three of the five events of the Firefighter Combat Challenge, plus a tug-o-war. The competition follows the rules of the Firefighter Combat Challenge® (On•Target Challenge, Inc.), developed by Dr. Paul Davis.

The competition will consist of 5-person teams. Each event, with the exception of Tug-o-war will be timed with time determining the winner. In each round of competition, a different team member will rotate to a different event, allowing each member to participate in all three events after three rounds. The top two teams with the two lowest total individual times advance to the tug-o-war event. The winner of the tug-o-war event will be declared the overall winner. The tug-of-war event will only be used for the top two teams after the three timed events.

Event 1 – Forced Entry

This event will use a prop barrier door. The contestant will have to use a pry bar and ax to break through a wood block jamming the break down door, and force the door open. Two members may be used to help break open the door. This event will be timed and the lowest time contestant will be declared the winner. The contestant's team will likewise register the victory.

Event 2 – Hose advance

The contestant must pull a charged firehose through a 100 ft obstacle course. If any obstacle is disturbed, a 5 second penalty will be assessed. The contestant must then drag a hose a distance of 75 feet, then must spray a target using the water hose, then place the water hose on the pavement. Failing to pull the hose 75 feet will result in the assessment of a 10 second penalty. This event will be timed and the lowest time contestant will be declared the winner. The contestant's team will likewise register the victory.

Event 3 – Victim Rescue

Contestant must lift and drag backward a mannequin a distance of 100 feet. The contestant must pull the entire mannequin across the finish line. This event will be timed and the lowest time contestant will be declared the winner. The contestant's team will likewise register the victory.

Event 4 – Tug-o-war

Each team will take opposite ends of the rope, the first team to pull the rope past the center line will be declared the winner. Teams will consist of 5 total team members.

Teams will receive prizes as determined by sponsor. Contest Officials decision will be final.
